NOTES:

1. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the Church's Gift Aid Convener
2. This Declaration will be valid for all Offerings and Donations you make to the Church, provided firstly that you pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the Church reclaims on such Offerings and/or Donations in the tax year; and secondly that the Church requires to be able to demonstrate to the Inland Revenue that the gift was given by you.
3. If, in the future, your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains an amount equal to or greater than the tax that the Church reclaims, you should cancel your Declaration (see 2).
4. If you pay income tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self-Assessment Tax Return. You may wish to take this into account in determining the amount of your gift.
5. This Gift Aid scheme introduces additional tax advantages in relation to Inheritance Tax and further details may be obtained from the Gift Aid convener.
